


Saving Video From DVR/NVR


Place your thumb drive into the USB slot of your DVR/NVR. Scroll down to the lower part of the monitor and open up the main menu

Select: "Export"


This will open up a secondary menu. From this menu select "Event"



This will bring you to the search page (seen below)




In this section you will choose which camera you would like to search for footage from.




You will then choose the time frame you would like to search from



Once you have done that, hit the “Search” button at the bottom of the screen. Once the DVR has finished searching, you will be presented with all of the video clips from that time frame




This is where you will select all of the video clips you want to download. Click the empty box to the left to select the clip



If you aren't sure if it is the one you want, you can highlight the clip and hit the play button to get a quick preview. Once you have all of the clips you want, click the "Export" button at the bottom.

The next screen displays all of your thumb drive information, and any files/folders that may be saved to it



You can choose to create a new folder in which to save your video clips, or you can choose not to. Simply click on “Export”

Once your clips have been saved, you may exit to the live view and remove your thumb drive
